ORDER DISCONTINUING CASE NO. 6071

On March 7, 1958 the Weimar Chest Center, a sanitarium located on Highway 40, between Colfax and Auburn in Placer County, filed a pleading to request that adequate bus stops be provided at the sanitarium and that suitable turnoffs be constructed to link the bus stops to the freeway. This case was consolidated with Case No. 6130 and during the hearing a representative from the Division of Highways, State Department of Public Works, testified that the Division of Highways would build all bus stops and turnoffs on Highway 40 from Sacramento to the California-Nevada State line. Decision No. 60003 was issued on April 26, 1960 providing, among other things, that Case No. 6130 would be discontinued and that Case No. 6071 would be continued until the bus stop facilities and turnoffs at Weimar were completed.

A recent inspection has confirmed that turnout lanes and concrete bus pads and platforms have been completed and are now being used by all buses stopping at the Weimar Sanitarium.

We hereby find that Case No. 6071 has accomplished its purpose and we conclude that the case should be discontinued.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 6071 is discontinued.
