IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2(c) of Decision No. 65713 which reads as follows:





The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
