SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 65721, dated July 16, 1963, the Commission authorized the State of California, Department of Public Works, to reconstruct State Route 15 (Sign Route 20) at separated grades under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Marysville, Yuba County, at the location shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. C-141.2-B.

On July 18, 1963, the State of California, Department of Public Works, filed a substitution of Exhibit B in this proceeding stating that after the filing of Application No. 45451 it was determined that Exhibit B, dated January 17, 1963, should be revised and, therefore, the Department substituted revised Exhibit B, dated January 17, 1963, and revised June 19, 1963, for the exhibit attached to the original application.

Therefore good cause appearing, the first sentence of Decision No. 65721 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to reconstruct State Route 15 (Sign Route 20) at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific

Company, in the City of Marysville, Yuba County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B, dated January 17, 1963, revised June 19, 1963) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. C-141.2-B."

In all other respects, Decision No. 65721 is in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
