O R D E R

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its Lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, are hereby authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Noakes Street in the City of Commerce, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3-4.10-C.

Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
