ORDER

Seaport Compress Company, applicant herein, is a California corporation which recently was authorized, by Decision No. 55656, dated July 9, 1963, to engage in business in Cakland as a public utility warehouseman. In this application it seeks authorization to borrow \$30,000 from Small Business Administration in order to obtain working capital, the borrowing to be represented by a 5-1/2% note payable, principal and interest, in monthly installments of \$326 with final payment five years after date of issue.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion, and finds, that the application should be granted; that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of the note herein authorized is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein; that such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income; and that a public hearing is not necessary.
