## O R D E R

United States of America, acting by and through the Department of the Navy, is hereby authorized to construct an access road at grade from a proposed military housing project on the Silver Strand in Coronado across the Coronado Branch Line of the San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36C-16.55, in the County of San Diego.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of the crossing shall be 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent, in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
