O R D E R

City of San Diego is hereby authorized to construct 69th Street at grade across the La Mesa Branch of the San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-7.75, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of the crossing shall be 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.



Upon completion of Crossing No. 36D-7.75, the existing crossing of 68th Street (Crossing No. 36D-7.6) shall be physically abandoned and closed.


Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.


