ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 65792

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 65792 issued July 30, 1963, in Case No. 7576 is amended to read:

"1. If, on or before the twentieth day after the effective date of this order, respondent has not paid the fine referred to in paragraph 7 of this order, then Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 31-603 issued to Walter L. Taylor shall be suspended for five days, starting at 12:01 a.m., on the second Monday following the twentieth day after said effective date, except that said suspension will not apply to the transportation of fresh or green fruit when the point of destination of the shipment is a cannery. Respondent shall not, by leasing the equipment or other facilities used in operations under this permit for the period of suspension, or by any other device, directly or indirectly allow such equipment or facilities to be used to circumvent the suspension."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
