O R D E R

The County of San Bernardino, in connection with the construction of grade separations for Etiwanda Avenue and a parallel service road, is hereby authorized to construct Slover Avenue at grade across a drill track of the Southern Pacific Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-527.61-C, near the City of Fontana, County of San Bernardino.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Width of the crossing shall be 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two

Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion of Crossing No. B-527.61-C, the existing crossing of Slover Avenue (Crossing No. B-527.6-C) shall be physically abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
