ORDER

The County of San Joaquin is hereby authorized to construct Anteros Avenue at grade across track of Southern Pacific Company near Stockton in San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. DC-93.1. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto. Copy of said agreement approved by Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-two feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. ✓

Applicant desires to commence construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
