O R D E R

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Marshall Avenue in the City of El Cajon, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-17.23-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width of 40 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent in accordance with plans attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period because of commitments entered into by the industry to be served and because of materials which will be en route to its plant.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
