Application of THE GREYHOUND CORPORATION for authority to conduct Special Operations between Buellton and Solvang, Santa Barbara County, over California Highway 150.

## OPINION AND ORDER

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to operate between Bucliton and Solvang over State Highway 150.

It is alleged that applicant, during the past few weeks, has received numerous requests for special tours to the community of Solvang in Santa Barbara County, to commence September 21, 1963; that applicant now possesses all the necessary operating authority to provide the service with the exception of the three miles between Buellton and Solvang.

After consideration the Commission finds that:

- 1. Public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought.
  - 2. A public hearing is not necessary.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Third Revised Page 47, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the

certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

- 2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Third Revised Page 47 in revision of Second Revised Page 47.
- 3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
  - (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
  - (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in the Commission's office in triplicate tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.
  - (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than two days after the effective date of this order on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
  - (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98.

APPENDIX A

THE GREYHOUND CORPORATION

Third Revised Page 47 Cancels Second Revised Page 47

15.16 - Between junction Alternate U. S. Highway 101 and Hueneme Road and Port Hueneme:

From junction Alternate U. S. Highway 101 and Hueneme Road, over Hueneme Road to Brand Street to Market Street to Main Street to Port Hueneme, to be operated on-call for 25 or more adult fares.

15.17 - Between West Thousand Oaks and East Thousand Oaks:

From junction U. S. Highway 101 and unnumbered highway (West Thousand Oaks), over unnumbered highway to junction U.S. Highway 101 (East Thousand Oaks).

15.18 - Between Calabasas Junction and Vineland Avenue Junction:

From junction U. S. Highway 101 and unnumbered highway (Calabasas Junction), over unnumbered highway via Tarzana to junction U. S. Highway 101 (Vineland Avenue Junction).

15.19 - Between North Ventura Junction and South Ventura Junction:

From North Ventura Junction, over unnumbered highway via Ventura to South Ventura Junction.

\*15.20 - Between Buellton and Solvang:

From the junction of U. S. Highway 101 and California Highway 150 (Buellton), over California Highway 150 to Solvang.

Service is authorized to be conducted in Special Operations only.
