The order prescribed protection in the form of one Standard No. I crossing sign reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. It now appears that two such signs are required. Therefore, good cause appearing. IT IS ORDERED that protection of said crossing be changed to read "Two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material".
