In the Matter of the Application of ALVIN J. HOFFMAN, an individual and sole proprietor, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a public utility water system in the name of Pan-Terra Water Company, and to establish flat rates for water service in a portion of the unincorporated area of the County of Santa Clara, State of California, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 65102, Alvin J. Hoffman, doing business as Pan-Terra Water Company, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system within a specified area in Santa Clara County. However, the effective date of portions of the order was to be established by supplemental order following completion of improvements to applicant's system.

By letters dated June 1, July 5, and July 31, 1962, applicant's attorney has indicated that the water system located in Holiday Lake Estates Subdivision Unit No. One now meets the minimum standards of this Commission's General Order No. 103 and requests authority to place in effect in that unit the rates authorized in the decision.

Accordingly, the Commission finds and concludes that applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted. However, applicant is placed on notice that rates are to be effective only in Holiday Lake Estates Subdivision Unit No. One. Further, the

tariff service area map delineating that unit is to be revised only subsequent to supplemental order of this Commission following applicant's completion of additional system improvements.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 7 of Decision No. 65102 is amended in the manner following:

7. Until further order of this Commission, applicant shall not provide water service to any premises outside of Holiday Lake Estates Subdivision Unit No. One which were not served by applicant's water system prior to April 8, 1963.

2. The effective date of ordering paragraphs 1, 3, 4, 5 and 8 of Decision No. 65102 as to water service to Holiday Lake Estates Subdivision Unit No. One only shall be the date hereof.

Except as hereinabove modified, Decision No. 65102 shall remain in full force and effect.

The order herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
