ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

By Decision No. 64149, dated August 21, 1962, applicant was authorized to transport specified lightweight aggregates from San Clemente to various destinations in southern California at lesser rates than those that would otherwise apply under minimum rate orders of the Commission. The authority so granted expires with October 1, 1963.

Applicant now seeks extension of the authority on a modified basis to October 1, 1964. It asks that the extension be granted by ex parte order. Interested parties, however, have requested that the matter be set for public hearing. In the circumstances it appears that a public hearing on the matter should be scheduled.

The authority heretofore granted will be extended for an additional period to permit consideration of, and decision on, the record adduced at the further hearing.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the date upon which the authority granted by Decision No. 64149 to Binswanger Services, Inc., will expire is extended to February 1, 1964.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
