BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades, the elimination of an existing crossing at grade and the construction of a new crossing at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, in connection with the construction of State Route IV-SM-214-RdwC, in the City of Redwood City, San Mateo County, referred to as "Redwood Junction Overhead".

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to construct one crossing at separated grades, to construct one new crossing at grade and to close and abolish one existing crossing at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company involving the construction of State Route IV-SM-214-RdwC in the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, at the locations and substantially as set forth in the above numbered application and in accordance with the following:

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D. Width of Crossing No. EA-26.91-C shall be not less than that shown on Exhibit C attached to the application and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be as shown in the Table of Crossing Data.

Upon completion of Redwood Junction Overhead (Crossing No. E-26.2-A), Southern Pacific Company shall abolish and close Crossing No. E-26.2.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
