ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, County Water Company, a corporation, seeks authority to transfer certain utility properties to the City of Norwalk.

By Decision No. 61483, dated February 14, 1961, in Application No. 42210, County Water Company was authorized to acquire from Suburban Mutual Water Company the facilities which it now proposes to sell to the City of Norwalk. The transfer authorization was conditioned upon compliance with several requirements set forth in detail in the order. The Commission's records show that the requirements were not met and that the authority to acquire the water system expired on September 30, 1961.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 45720 is dismissed without prejudice.
