Decision No. 66116

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the County of San Luis Obispo, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades whereby Price Canyon Road, (F.A.S. Route V-SLO-680(1)) will be carried over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, in San Luis Obispo County, referred to as "Price Canyon Road Overhead".

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 64509, November 7, 1962, in the above entitled proceeding, applicant, County of San Luis Obispo, was authorized to construct Price Canyon Road at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company near Edna, San Luis Obispo County.

On July 10, 1963, the County of San Luis Obispo filed a petition for modification of the requirement contained in Decision No. 64509, for the physical closing and removal of the existing Crossing No. E-258.2 by Southern Pacific Company, to provide instead that the crossing revert to private crossing status. By letter of August 20, 1963, the Southern Pacific Company interposed no objection to the petition for modification, provided that the company is able to execute a suitable agreement with the property owner, and that gates are installed on both sides of the railroad right of way at the crossing, and these gates are kept closed and locked when not in use. This request has been investigated by the Commission staff, and it is recommended that the petition for modification be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the second paragraph of Decision No. 64509 be changed to read "Upon completion of Price Canyon Road Overhead, Southern Pacific Company shall close Crossing No. E-258.2 (existing Price Canyon Road

Crossing), located approximately 0.2 mile westerly, to public use and travel. Gates shall be installed at both sides of the crossing, which are to be kept closed and locked when not in use."

In all other respects Decision No. 64509 shall remain in full force and effect.
