BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Investigation into the rates, rules, regulations, charges, allowances and practices of all common carriers, highway carriers and city carriers relating to the transportation of any and all commodities between and within all points and places in the State of California (including, but not limited to, transportation for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2).

OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition Pacific Kenyon Corporation, a processor of animal feed supplements, seeks the inclusion of diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and urea (feed grade) in the grouping of commodities identified generally as "Feed, Animal or Poultry" in List No. 4 of Item No. 652½ series, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

Petitioner states that the transportation characteristics of diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and of urea (feed grade) are similar to those of many of the products now included in List No. 4, and that said commodities are sold in direct competition with dicalcium phosphate (feed grade) and blood meal -- both of which are named in the list. Petitioner asserts that because of the similarity of transportation characteristics and because of the competition involved diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and urea (feed grade) should also be named in List No. 4

in order that they may be subject to the same rates that apply for the transportation of the other commodities so named.

The California Farm Bureau Federation supports petitioner's request. The California Trucking Association has informed the Commission that it has no objection to the ex parte consideration requested.

We find that the inclusion of diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and of urea (feed grade) in the aforesaid List No. 4 has been shown to be justified. The petition will be granted. Public hearing thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 30, 1963, Thirtieth Revised Page 8, Twenty-eighth Revised Page 9 and Fifth Revised Page 49-A, which revised pages are attached hereto and by this reference are made a part hereof.

(2) Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

In all other respects, the aforesaid Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
