OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition Pacific Kenyon Corporation, a processor of animal feed supplements, seeks the inclusion of diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and urea (feed grade) in the grouping of commodities identified generally as "Feed, Animal or Poultry" in List No. 4 of Item No. 652% series, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

Petitioner states that the transportation characteristics of diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and of urea (feed grade) are similar to those of many of the products now included in List No. 4, and that said commodities are sold in direct competition with dicalcium phosphate (feed grade) and blood meal—both of which are named in the list. Petitioner asserts that because of the similarity of transportation characteristics and because of the competition involved diammonium phosphate (feed grade) and urea (feed grade) should also be named in List No. 4

In all other respects, the aforesaid Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
