By Decision No. 65901 the operating authority of Al Scannavino, doing business as Al Scannavino Trucking, was enlarged so as to include the transportation of the following:



Applicant herein requests that Decision No. 65901 be modified so as to include a finding that public convenience and necessity require the transportation of the same products in Interstate and Foreign Commerce.

It is alleged that 50 percent of the bulk commodities and 30 percent of the package commodities authorized by Decision No. 65901 would be transported in Interstate or Foreign Commerce.

The notice was published in the Federal Register. No protest has been received.
