ORDER OF MODIFICATION

Tankliner Service, Inc. was authorized to sell and transfer certain operating rights to Suburban Tank Lines, a California corporation, by Decision No. 65982, dated September 10, 1963.

It appearing that ordering paragraph 1 inadvertently refers to Tankliner Service, Inc., the seller, instead of Suburban Tank Lines, the buyer, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 65982 is amended as follows:

1. The transfer of the certificates of public convenience and necessity described herein is authorized upon the condition that whenever Suburban Tank Lines engages other carriers as sub-haulers in connection with the transportation of property for Suburban Gas, or of the customers or suppliers of Suburban Gas, the carriers so engaged shall be paid not less than the published tariff rates of Suburban Tank Lines.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
