O P I N I O N

A number of the Commission's minimum rate tariffs are
 subject to the Western Classification for class ratings or other
 provisions. Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 (General Commodities,
 Statewide) and 5 (Los Angeles drayage area) are also governed by

Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Exception Sheet No. 1-S, Cal PUC No. 193. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (Cement) makes reference to the exception sheet, but it has no application to that tariff.

By order dated November 27, 1962, the Commission ordered a hearing to be held to consider the recommendation of the Transportation Division that the Commission issue an Exception Ratings Tariff to replace Exception Sheet No. 1-S. By the above-numbered petitions, filed March 26, 1963, the California Trucking Association seeks elimination of all references to Exception Sheet No. 1-S.

These matters were consolidated and public hearings were held before Examiner Turpen on July 2, 1963, at San Francisco and on July 9, 1963, at Los Angeles.

A transportation rate expert offered in evidence a proposed Exception Ratings Tariff. The witness explained that in general such tariff reproduced all material in Exception Sheet No. 1-S, omitting all material extraneous to California minimum rates. He said that it would greatly simplify the use of exception ratings in connection with the minimum rates. In adapting the provisions, the witness said that minor technical increases and reductions might occur, but other than this no changes in the ratings or rules are involved. The witness also proposed certain changes in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5 which would be necessary to change references to the exception sheet.

The proposed change in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 requires discussion. Item No. 220 provides an exception rating on used carriers "as described in and subject to the provisions of Item No. 300 of the Exception Sheet". The witness proposed that a note reading "Subject to minimum rate of 29 cents per hundred pounds or

actual 4th class rate, whichever is lower" be added. The witness said that this note is part of the provisions of Item No. 300 of the Exception Sheet and that placing it in Item No. 220 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 will result in no change. A number of parties disagreed and claimed that the note in question does not apply. An examination of Item No. 300 of the Exception Sheet shows that the note in question is part of the rating superseded by Item No. 220 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. It is therefore clear, and we find that the note does not apply and should not be incorporated in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5.

Although the California Trucking Association proposes in its petitions to cancel all references to Exception Sheet No. 1-S, its research director introduced an exhibit and testified that the association concurred in the staff proposal, except that petitioner proposes cancellation of a number of exception ratings. Most of those proposed to be canceled, according to the witness, are commodities for which he could find little or no movement, or duplicated ratings in the classification or the minimum rate tariffs. A few of those proposed to be canceled have ratings which he said were unrealistic or too low. However, the witness did not present any evidence to show that these ratings were unreasonable. It appears, and we find that those ratings for which petitioner found little or no movement, or duplicate other provisions, should be canceled, but that the others should not be canceled.

Petitioner also proposed that the ratings be designated as "truckload" and "less-than-truckload" instead of "carload" and "less-than-carload". As the minimum rate tariffs are mainly for truck traffic, he said, these designations would be better. He also said

that future plans may include the use of a motor classification, and the different designation of ratings at this time will make many tariff changes unnecessary at a later date. This suggestion has merit and will be adopted.

Items Nos. 690 and 710 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 name commodity rates on lumber and forest products. The items provide that after certain distances class rates apply. Petitioner's director of research said that if this rate is changed to provide that Class B rates apply, a lengthy description and exception rating in the exception sheet can be canceled. This will be done in the interest of tariff simplification.

The Commission finds that the Exception Ratings Tariff, as proposed by the Commission's Transportation Division, modified as discussed above, should be adopted to govern the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5, in lieu of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Exception Sheet No. 1-S. The Commission further finds that any changes in classification ratings resulting are reasonable and have been shown to be justified, and that the resulting minimum rates and charges will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory. The changes necessary to reflect such substitution in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5 will be made by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution. Cancellation of references to the exception sheet in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 will also be made by separate order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:
