SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Allyn Tank Line, Inc., a corporation, has authority to operate as a highway common carrier and as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in bulk and in tank trucks between all points and places in California. Its amended articles of incorporation have been filed with this Commission changing its corporate name to Allyn Transportation Company. Its operating certificates will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

The carrier is required by general order to amend its tariffs immediately to show the new name of the company (General Order No. 80-A, Rule 6.4).

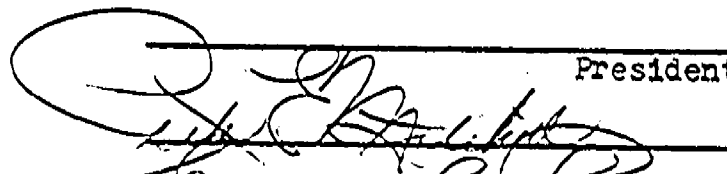

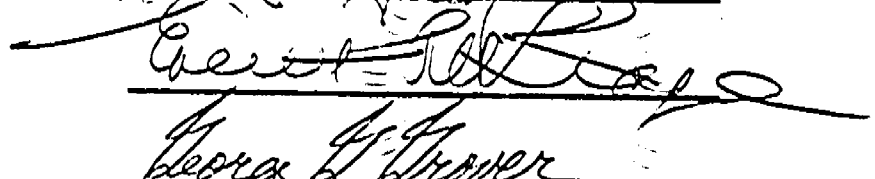
IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 50313 dated July 27, 1954, in Application No. 35519, and Decision No. 57786 dated December 30,

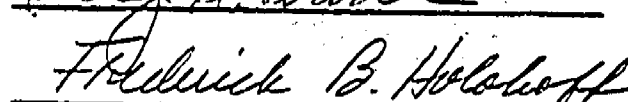
1958, in Application No. 40500, are amended by substituting "Allyn Transportation Company" in place and stead of "Allyn Tank Line, Inc."
