ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Harrison Frederick, Trustee for Reilley Truck Line, Bankrupt, by petition filed January 17, 1963, in this proceeding requested an order extending the suspension of the highway common carrier and public utility warehouse operative rights of Reilley Truck Line to July 31, 1963, and relieving Reilley from the provisions of General Order No. 100-B and Sections 486 and 489 of the Public Utilities Code.

Subsequent to the above-referred to filing the operative rights herein involved were authorized to be sold (Decision No. 65633 dated July 2, 1963, in Application No. 45407, and Decision No. 66103 dated October 1, 1963, in Application No. 45327). By letter dated August 2, 1963, petitioner requests that the above petition in Application No. 43948 be dismissed.
