OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common, highway contract and city carrier permits.¹ By Decision No. 64368 dated October 9, 1962, he was authorized as a city carrier to charge less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of flour for eight flour companies within the City and County of San Francisco.² The authority is scheduled to expire November 4, 1963.

By this application authority is sought to continue to charge the currently authorized rates until November 4, 1964.

Applicant alleges that the need for the relief sought herein is the same as it was at the time of the filing of the original application; that the proposed rates are fully compensatory; and that based upon his experience during the past year and taking into consideration the proposed rates he is satisfied that he can continue to provide the service herein involved at a satisfactory profit.

¹ Applicant is also authorized to operate as a highway common carrier of general commodities between points in northern California not involved herein.

² The flour companies are: Centennial Mills, Inc., Coast Dakota Flour Company, Cook Flour Company, Fisher Flour Mills, General Mills, Joe Lowe Corporation, Monarch Flour Company and Terminal Flour Mills Company.

Applicant further alleges that, should the established minimum rates be increased during the ensuing year, he intends to increase comparably the authorized less-than-minimum rates.

The verified application shows that a copy thereof was served on the California Trucking Association on or about September 3, 1963. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates and charges, as hereinafter adjusted, are reasonable and consistent with the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted and applicant's proposed rates and charges will be modified to reflect adjustments in the minimum rates authorized by Decisions Nos. 65834 and 65841 dated August 6, 1963, in Case No. 5441 (Order Setting Hearing dated April 10, 1962).

In view of the expiration date of the current authority, the order which follows will be made effective on November 4, 1963.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Bruno Albert Malucchi, doing business as A. M. Devincenzi Company, is hereby authorized as a city carrier to transport flour, with not to exceed six percent chemical ingredients, for Centennial Mills, Inc., Coast Dakota Flour Company, Cook Flour Company, Fisher Flour Mills, General Mills, Joe Lowe Corporation, Monarch Flour Company and Terminal Flour Mills Company from his warehouse and terminal in San Francisco to points and places within the City and County limits of San Francisco, at rates less than minimum rates but not less than those set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after November 4, 1963, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 64368, and shall expire with November 4, 1964.

The effective date of this order shall be November 4, 1963.
