FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 64988, dated February 19, 1963, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Marine Water Company to construct and operate a public utility water system within specified areas of San Bernardino County. Ordering paragraph 2 required that applicant provide for the continuation of an adequate supply of water during periods when the initial source is temporarily out of service. Ordering paragraph 5 authorized the filing of tariffs, after compliance with ordering paragraph 2, as evidenced by a supplemental order to that effect.

By letter dated August 30, 1963, applicant's attorney reports that an alternate supply has been installed and placed in operation and provides details of how this has been accomplished.

The Commission finds that compliance with ordering paragraph 2 has been effected and concludes that applicant should be authorized to file tariffs.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Marine Water Company may proceed with the tariff filing referred to in ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 64988.
2. In all other respects, Decision No. 64988 shall remain in full force and effect.
