ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This is an application for an order of the Commission authorizing Allan Arthur Transportation, Inc., to encumber equipment and to issue a note in the principal amount of \$157,000 in connection with certain refinancing transactions.

By Decision No. 66145, dated October 15, 1963, in Application No. 45288, the Commission revoked applicant's certificate of public convenience and necessity, thus removing the company from public utility status as defined in the Public Utilities Code.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that Allan Arthur Transportation, Inc., is not a public utility as defined in the California Public Utilities Code, and that it may encumber the equipment and issue the note without authorization by this Commission. On the basis of such findings, we conclude that the application should be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 45725 is hereby dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
