Application of the CITY OF ORANGE to establish a grade crossing at Palmyra Avenue over and across an industrial drill track of the Southern Pacific Railway Company approximately 1300 feet west of Prospect Avenue.

ORDER

City of Orange is hereby authorized to construct Palmyra Avenue at grade across the Tustin Branch track of the Southern Pacific Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BM-518.6, in the City of Orange, County of Orange.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of the crossing shall be 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent, in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
