ORDER

City of Brea is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across the Pacific Electric Railway Company's La Habra Line at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6C-24.89-D, in the City of Brea, County of Orange.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Facific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of the pedestrian crossing shall be 5 feet and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two special signs as described in the application, as well as the installation of barrier posts at either end of the crossing to prevent use by motor vehicles.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
