THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 63469, dated March 27, 1962, in this proceeding, provides that a certificate of public convenience and necessity will be granted to Garden Water Corporation upon compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraph 2 of that decision.

The Commission finds that compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraph 2 has been effected and concludes that the certificate should be granted to applicant.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Garden Water Corporation, a corporation, authorizing it to acquire, construct and operate a public utility water system for the distribution and sale of water within Tract No. 2550, located in the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 9, T.29S., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., in Kern County.

2. In all other respects, except as modified by previous supplemental orders, Decision No. 63469 shall remain in full force and effect.
