## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 65732, dated July 23, 1963, in this proceeding, the Commission authorized Oakland Bean Cleaning and Storage Company, Inc., on or before September 30, 1963, to issue not to exceed 8,000 shares of its common stock without par value in part payment for a certain warehouse operative right and related assets.

The company, through its attorneys, now reports that, because of misunderstandings, it did not issue the shares prior to the September 30, 1963 expiration date and requests an extension of time for issuing said shares.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion, and finds, that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of said 8,000 shares of stock is reasonably required for the purpose referred to in said Decision No. 65732, which purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income. On the basis of these findings, we conclude that the request should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

The authority herein granted is not to be construed as indicative of amounts to be included in future proceedings for the purpose of determining just and reasonable rates.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Oakland Bean Cleaning and Storage Company, Inc., on or before January 31, 1964, may issue the not to exceed 8,000 shares of its common stock without par value authorized in Decision No. 65732, dated July 23, 1963, for the purpose referred to therein.
- 2. Oakland Bean Cleaning and Storage Company, Inc., shall file with this Commission a report, or reports, as required by General Order No. 24-A, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.
- 3. This First Supplemental Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
