ORDER PERMANENTLY STAYING OPERATIVE EFFECT  
OF DECISION NO. 62117 AND DISMISSING APPLICATION

By Decision No. 62117 issued on June 6, 1961 in the above-entitled proceeding, the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Southern California Gas Company and to Southern Counties Gas Company of California to construct certain facilities in California for use in connection with the so-called Rock Springs project. Thereafter, on July 25, 1961, the Commission issued its order staying the operative effect of said Decision No. 62117 pending further order of the Commission.

Construction of said Rock Springs project required the authorization of the Federal Power Commission (FPC). The FPC having denied the request to construct said project and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 62117 is hereby set aside and vacated and Application No. 40588 is hereby dismissed.
