O P I N I O N

Certified Freight Lines, Inc. requests that its operating authority as a highway common carrier be amended by excluding therefrom the authority to transport fertilizer.

It is alleged that fertilizer is a commodity exempt from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and that applicant would be in a better position to serve many of its agricultural customers if the authority herein sought were granted.

After consideration the Commission finds that granting of the authority herein sought would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Certified Freight Lines, Inc. is hereby authorized to discontinue the transportation of fertilizer as a highway common carrier effective concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings required in paragraph 3 hereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 62940 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 4, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 4.

3. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
