**O R D E R**

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to relocate an existing spur track at grade across Second and Third Streets, to relocate an existing spur track at grade across Third Street, and to construct an additional spur track at grade across Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Streets in the City of Chico, Butte County, at the locations described in the application, and identified as shown in the table below. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection (General Order No. 75-B) shall be as shown in the following table:

C-184.0	Seventh Street	Construct spur track	1 Std. No. 3 wigwag. 2 Std. No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
