## QPINIQ

Complainont seeks restoration of celopione service at 1730 Brederick Street, apartments numbered 1 and 4, in San Francisco, California. Interim restoration was ordered pending further order (Decision No. 66092).

Deferdant's answer alleges that on or about June 25, 1962, iた hai reasonable eause to believe that service to complainant under number WE 1-7690 was being or was to be used as an instrumentality to violate the Law, and thercfore defendant was requince ice dissonnect service pursuant to the eceision in Re Telepinone Disconnection, 47 Cal. P.ü.C. 853.

The matter was heard and submitted before Examiner Row at san Franctisce on November 22, 2963.

Compainant entered into a stipulation that defenciant had \#easonajle cause for its action. Complainant tescified that she hed need for the telephone service and that she did nor and will not
use the telephone for any unlawful purpose. There was no testimony from any law enforcement agency.

We find that defendant's action was based upon reasonable cause, and the evidence fails to show that the telephone was used for any illegal purpose. The Commission concludes that complainant is entitled to service.
