INTERIM ORDER

San Jose City Lines, Inc. asks that the requirements of ordering paragraph 6 of Decision No. 62960, dated December 19, 1961, in this proceeding be suspended. Said paragraph states:

"6. San Jose City Lines, Inc., shall acquire 37 new motor buses in replacement of older buses prior to January 1, 1967 and the number of buses acquired and the dates of acquisition shall not be less in number or in time than specified in the following schedule:

<u>No. of Buses</u>	<u>Shall be Acquired Prior to:</u>
5	November 1, 1962
8	January 1, 1964
8	January 1, 1965
8	January 1, 1966
8	January 1, 1967"

Applicant states that it purchased the five buses required by November 1, 1962 and that it does not now have the resources with which to purchase the eight buses by January 1, 1964.

This matter has been scheduled for public hearing. A decision in the matter cannot be made, however, prior to January 1, 1964; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the requirements of ordering paragraph 6 of Decision No. 62960 in this proceeding are suspended until further order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
