ORDER REOPENING FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION

By Decision No. 65997, dated September 10, 1963, the County of San Joaquin was authorized to construct Anteros Avenue at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company near the City of Stockton. Construction and maintenance expense were to be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties. The parties were placed upon notice that if they failed to agree the Commission would reopen the proceeding and determine the apportionment of installation and maintenance costs by further order.

With the exception of the installation of Standard No. 8 flashing light signals the crossing is now completed, but the parties have been unable to reach a mutual agreement on installation and maintenance costs.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof Southern Pacific Company shall install two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals at the Anteros Avenue grade crossing.
