OPINION AND ORDER

Case No. 7024 is an investigation instituted on November 22, 1960, by the Commission upon its own motion into the constructive mileages, and related rules and provisions, of any and all carriers of property including common carriers, as defined in the Public Utilities Act, radial highway common carriers, highway contract carriers, petroleum contract carriers, household goods carriers, and city carriers, as defined in the Public Utilities Code, engaged in the transportation of any and all commodities between all points in California (including, but not limited to, constructive mileages provided in the distance table). Upon recommendation of the Transportation Division staff, the Commission, on December 20, 1960, issued its order setting hearing in this proceeding for the receipt of evidence regarding constructive mileages and related distance provisions in the distance table and in other minimum rate tariffs.

After due notice, public hearings were held starting April 11, 1961, and concluding with the fourteenth day of hearing on October 25, 1961. Examiner William E. Turpen filed his proposed report on March 9, 1962, exceptions and replies were received, and the matter was submitted on May 14, 1962. Thereafter, the Commission

issued its decision¹ adopting Distance Table No. 5 to be effective February 1, 1964, and to be prepared, printed and served prior to its being made applicable to any minimum rate tariff.

Distance Table No. 5 consists of the two parts designated Part 1 and Part 2 which shall accompany and be served with this decision of which they are made a part by reference.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Distance Table No. 5 shall consist of two parts, designated Part 1 and Part 2, which accompany this order and by this reference are hereby made a part hereof.


2. Distance Table No. 5 shall be effective February 1, 1964, but shall not be applicable to any minimum rate tariff until so ordered in a minimum rate proceeding pertaining to that minimum rate tariff.


3. The Secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this order to be served forthwith upon the respondents to this proceeding and upon all other parties of record.




