OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 66256, dated November 5, 1963, in Application No. 45238, Southern California Water Company (applicant) was authorized to provide service to approximately 1,710 acres of land in Simi Valley, Ventura County, California, with the proviso that it could not extend service to that portion of the certificated area east of Sycamore Road without further order of the Commission. Applicant hereby requests authority to extend service east of Sycamore Road to approximately 284 acres of land in two areas, one containing approximately 242 acres and the other containing approximately 42 acres. Applicant alleges that said areas are presently being developed; that it has entered into preliminary contracts for extension of service thereto; that all extensions will be made in conformity with its filed rules and regulations; and that the rates for water service will be those specified in Decision No. 66256, supra.

By said Decision No. 66256, the Commission found that applicant has the public utility capability to provide, and that public convenience and necessity require that it extend, service to the certificated area but that the developer's plans for the eastern portion of the area were not firm. The areas referred to

in this application are in the area withheld from service by Decision No. 66256.

Upon the allegations of the application herein we find that public convenience and necessity require that applicant extend service to the areas described in the order herein, and that a public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant be and it hereby is authorized to extend service to those areas in Simi Valley, Ventura County, bounded and described as follows:

Area 1 (consisting of approximately 242 acres)

Bound on the North by Cochran Street, on the South by Los Angeles Avenue, on the West by Sycamore Drive and on the East by Sequoia Street.

Area 2 (consisting of approximately 42 acres)

Bound on the North by the proposed Freeway, on the South by Cochran Street, on the West by Sycamore Drive and on the East by a line which is parallel to and approximately 1,400 feet easterly of Sycamore Drive, extending from Cochran Street to the proposed Freeway.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
