OPINION AND ORDER

John R. Allen and Doris V. Allen, doing business as Ramona Stage Lines, request authority to suspend passenger stage service between Escondido and El Cajon via Ramona, until July 1, 1964.

The authority was granted by Decision No. 66023, dated September 17, 1963, in Application No. 45965. Service was commenced on October 7, 1963, and operated for a period of 24 days. During this period 155 passengers were transported, for a total revenue of \$150.35, while expenses totaled \$852.63. The cost of employing a driver amounted to \$484.80. Upon Mr. Allen's discharge from the Navy in June of 1964, he will do his own driving and it is possible that in time the operation may become economically feasible.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the granting of the application would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operating authority granted by Decision No. 66023 in Application No. 45965 is hereby suspended until July 1, 1964.

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicants shall amend their tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
