ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 54460 dated January 29, 1957, in Application No. 37805 (As amended), John A. Hilderbrand was granted a passenger stage and express operative right authorizing service between Trinity Center and Redding and intermediate points; that, during the month of July 1963, John A. Hilderbrand, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between Trinity Center and Redding pursuant to the foregoing described operative right; that, since July 29, 1963, John A. Hilderbrand has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-A; and that John A. Hilderbrand has expressed his desire to discontinue service due to the cancellation of his mail route contract by the United States Post Office Department; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage and express operative rights, created by Decision No. 54460 in Application No. 37805 (As amended), are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of John A. Hilderbrand are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon John A. Hilderbrand or to mail a certified copy thereof to John A. Hilderbrand at French Gulch, California, his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after such service upon John A. Hilderbrand or after the above mailing to John A. Hilderbrand, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written responses to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
