BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of three crossings at separated grades and abandonment of four crossings at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, in connection with the improvement of State Highway X-Sta-4-A, Cer, A, in Stanislaus County, referred to as "Service Road Overcrossing", "Pine Street Overcrossing", and "Whitmore Avenue Overcrossing".

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to construct Service Road as a temporary crossing at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Modesto, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-118.08. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon opening of temporary Crossing No. B-118.08, existing Crossing No. B-118.1 shall be abandoned and closed to public use and travel.

Upon completion of the proposed separation of grade structure, Crossing No. B-118.1-A, said temporary crossing shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant

to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Construction is programmed to start as soon as possible. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
