O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to widen the existing "Indian Agency Underpass" under the tracks of the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the County of San Diego, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 36-77.3-B.

Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
