ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The above-entitled application was filed on November 7, 1962, and was set for hearing on June 3 and 4, 1963. At the request of the applicant, the matter was removed from calendar to be reset. On June 3, 13, 27, September 17 and 23, 1963, the Commission requested information from the applicant as to when it would be ready for hearing. On September 24, 1963, the applicant advised the Commission that it was developing engineering and accounting information for amendment to the application which would enable it to prepare for hearing.

On or about November 1, 1963, the applicant advised the Commission that an election was to be held on or about November 15, 1963, for the issuance of general obligation bonds for funds with which the Yucca Valley County Water District would acquire the applicant's water system. From information available to the Commission, it appears that the bond issue was rejected. On December 3, 1963, the applicant was advised that the application would be dismissed because of delay.

On December 13, 1963, the applicant advised this Commission that although the bond issue was rejected on first election, a second

election thereon has been scheduled for February 11, 1964. The applicant requested that the instant application be held in abeyance pending this election.

On December 23, 1963, this Commission advised the applicant that the application herein would be dismissed.

Upon the record herein the Commission finds that the above-entitled application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The application herein, being Application No. 44931, be, and it hereby is, dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
