ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND MODIFYING DECISION

Industrial Communications System, Inc., having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 66101, and for reopening of the record and oral argument, and the Commission having considered said petition and each and every allegation therein, and being of the opinion that no good cause for granting rehearing, reopening, or oral argument has been made to appear,

IT IS ORDERED that said petition be, and the same is, hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 on sheets 11 and 12 of Decision No. 66101 is hereby modified to read as follows:

"3. Upon filing of an application and a showing that a construction permit and license has been issued by the Federal Communications Commission to applicant, and that applicant has secured the necessary permits from local authorities to construct transmitting facilities at the proposed site, an appropriate order shall issue granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise all rights and privileges granted under said construction permit and license."
