OPINION AND ORDER

Alma Mae Marsh, doing business as Felix Marsh Transfer, holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier, household goods carrier and city carrier permits. Decision No. 64759, dated January 8, 1963, in Application No. 45011, authorized her to assess rates and charges in cents per hour or per piece as named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A (used household goods), in lieu of the minimum rates otherwise applicable in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, in connection with transportation of property for the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, Western Electric Company and Radio Corporation of America. The current authority is scheduled to expire February 1, 1964. By this application she seeks remewal of this authority.

Applicant alleges that at all times since the granting of the previous authority applicant has performed service for the shippers all as alleged in the previous application and as set forth in Decision No. 64759, and all the conditions under which the services were performed have remained the same.

The authority was first granted by Decision No. 47215, dated June 5, 1952, in Case No. 4808, and has been extended and modified by subsequent decisions.

This order shall become effective February 1, 1964.
