On December 12, 1963, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company filed their petition for rehearing of Decision No. 66422, dated December 3, 1963. On January 14, 1964, by Decision No. 66595, the Commission denied rehearing. A petition to vacate Decision No. 66595, stay the effective date of Decision No. 66422 and to reconsider Decision No. 66422 was filed by said petitioners on January 31, 1964.

It appearing to the Commission that through mistake and inadvertence, Decision No. 66595 contains a typographical error, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first line of the second paragraph

on page 1 of said Decision 66595 is hereby amended by substituting the figure "9" in place of the figure "8".

IT IS ORDERED that said petition to vacate Decision No. 66595, to stay the effective date of Decision No. 66422 and to reconsider Decision No. 66422, as amended herein, is hereby denied.
