OPINION AND ORDER

Rossi Transportation, Inc. and Lee Jefford, doing business as Jefford Tank Lines, operate as a statewide petroleum irregular route carrier. In this application, they seek an order from this Commission authorizing them to execute a lease agreement relating to tank truck and tank trailer units and containing an option to purchase. A copy of the proposed lease agreement is attached to the application as Exhibit 1.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that the proposed lease agreement would not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Rossi Transportation, Inc. and Lee Jefford may execute and carry out the terms of a lease agreement in the same form, or in substantially the same form, as that attached to the application as Exhibit 1.
