FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

to evidence repayment of the same.

By Decision No. 49928, dated April 20, 1954, in this proceeding, the Commission authorized Malibu Water Company to execute an agreement with the State of California, acting through the Department of Public Works, providing for the advance by the State to applicant of the sum of \$37,425 to finance relocation costs, and requiring applicant to repay the advance in ten equal annual installments. The company reports that it has been unable to repay the advance in accordance with terms of said agreement and that the balance owing is \$11,838.

Applicant now proposes to execute a new agreement with the State of California, acting through the Department of Public Works, extending the time for payment of said \$11,838 balance. The new agreement will permit applicant to make monthly payments on the \$11,838 balance over a period of thirty-four months and will provide for interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of 4% per annum payable quarterly.
